Each year, peta2 selects top college animal rights activists from around the U.S. and Canada to participate in our Leadership Program, a distance-learning internship that helps train the future leaders of the animal rights movement. Leadership Program members work closely with peta2 staff to raise awareness about cruelty to animals through efforts on their own campus.

#### Receive Academic Credit

Students can register their Leadership Program participation for academic credit with their college or university as a way of integrating animal rights activism into their academic curriculum. This allows students to dedicate greater amounts of time and energy to the animal rights movement while still pursuing their undergraduate education.

#### Get Advanced Training

Each Leadership Program member is paired with a peta2 employee who serves as a personal mentor and advisor. By working with their advisor and attending national/regional animal rights conferences, Leadership Program members will learn leadership, marketing, media, organizing, and activist skills that will aid them in furthering animal rights on their campus.
